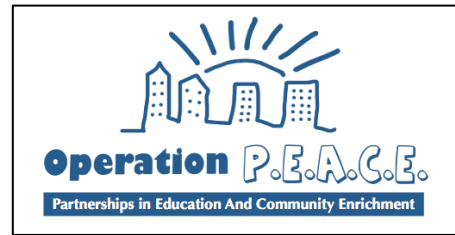

Dear Peterborough Senior Center friends,

Operation P.E.A.C.E. is continuing to monitor information and guidance from the city, state, and Age Strong Commission. At this point, we do not have a set date for re-opening the physical space of the Peterborough Senior Center. However, as of April 30th, the Baker administration announced that face coverings will only be required outside when it is not possible to socially distance. The CDC has also stated that fully vaccinated people can go without a mask outdoors, except in crowded settings. Given this news, we are excited to share that we will offer one **outdoor, in person, Coffee & Conversation** in May and two in June (*weather permitting*). Coffee and breakfast items will be available. Please note that this will be our first attempt at resuming anything in-person. While restrictions are beginning to lift, we will require anyone attending to follow public health guidelines and accept responsibility for any personal risk taken by attending.

Other than the specific Coffee & Conversation sessions noted in the calendar, all programs in May and June are virtual through Zoom. If you have any questions about joining a Zoom program, please let us know. If you are calling into a program, please check with your phone provider to see if long distance rates apply.
